

TrEES' School Programme 2009

“Connecting the Community to Taman Negeri Selangor – the Forest that Provides Sustenance to Life in Selangor”

Under TrEES school programme this year, a total of 13 schools in Selangor, 8 secondary and 5 primary, are currently working with TrEES to raise awareness on Taman Negeri Selangor (TNS) among their school communities. With support from Community Link - CIMB Foundation, YTL Climate Change Week and the Selangor Forestry Department, students and teachers have been learning about Taman Negeri Selangor and its importance, and spreading this knowledge among their classmates, teachers and parents.

Activities organised by the students and teachers to spread the awareness in their respective schools include:

- Fun quizzes and games
- Scrap books on TNS
- Videos of TNS
- Singing and music competitions
- Collage and poster competitions
- Save water - awareness stickers and labels
- Talks and skits on TNS
- Reduction of waste by recycling of papers and composting of organic waste
- Pledge banners
- Exhibitions and launches

All the activities are focused on raising awareness on the existence and importance of TNS and how students can help protect TNS by practicing the 4R's (rethink, reduce, reuse, recycle) in their daily lives.
